

Terms & Conditions:-

1. Candidates must be Indian Citizen as defined in Article 5 to 8 of the constitution of India.
2. Candidates already serving in Govt. Department should submit their applications through proper channel.
3. Candidates must not be less than 18 years of age or more than 43 years in case of General Candidates, 45 years for OBC/MOBC and 47 years for SC/ST as on the last date of submission of the application.

The application with self attested copies of all testimonials regarding Educational Qualification, Age, Caste, along with three (3) copies of recent passport size photographs, duly signed by the candidate on the reverse side should reach the office of the undersigned within 02-09-2020 by 4:15 PM. No application will be entertained after the scheduled time.
5. The applicant should mention their Mobile Numbers in the application form, if available.
6. The last date of receipt of application is 02-09-2020. No application will be accepted after the last date of submission of application i.e., on (02.09.2020). The undersigned shall not be responsible under any

7. Envelop containing application should indicate the name of the post applied for on the top in Block letters as "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF PEON".

The eligible candidates applying for the post shall be required to appear for personal interview the date of which will be uploaded on the official website of Nalbari District Judiciary(<http://nalbarijudiciary.gov.in>). In the prevailing pandemic situation written test can not be held as resolved/decided by the Board.

 12. Application received late or without proper supporting documents or undersigned or without photographs or incomplete Application Form will be summarily rejected.


